ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Support older Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to understand and engage with the aged care system, to receive greater local support.

Our community flexible aged care program aims to support Elders to maintain their wellbeing while remaining in community across Gumbaynggirr Country.

Increase the number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people receiving care on Gumbaynggirr Country.

We yarn with our Elders and communities about what is important to them and how we can best deliver services to support our Elders.



HOW TO ACCESS SERVICES

Galambila delivers care and support under the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Flexible Aged Care Program for people who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, as well as people who are accepted by the Community.

Elders can be referred to the service either through self-referral, be referred by local provider or via My Aged Care.



Self-referral
Elders can attend, or phone, Galambila to discuss their aged care options.



By providers
Local providers can contact Galambila on our Elders behalf to request services.



My Aged Care
Following an aged care assessment, Elders can be referred to our Flexible Aged Care Program via My Aged Care.
