

The Integrated Team Care Program (ITC) aims to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People with a chronic condition.

The care coordinator and outreach worker are here to support you to manage and understand your chronic condition. The supplementary services fund allows us to financially support you with specialist or allied health consults that are included in your Care Plan.

It also includes:

- Medical Aids
- Travel
- Radiology and Pathology
- Up to \$250 for spectacles

Unfortunately, it does **NOT** include:

- Dental
- Surgeries
- medication

Please note that while we understand some specialist services can be unpredictable with appointment times, we require at least 3 days notice of your appointment details for us to best support your journey.

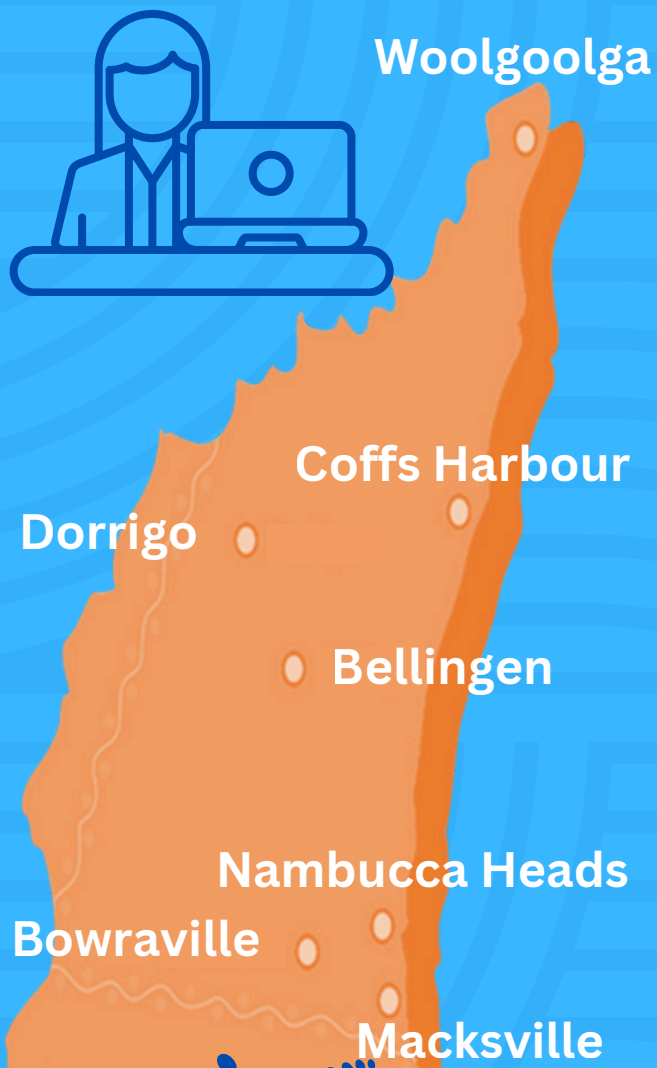

Eligibility criteria for Aboriginal Care Coordination ITC

To be eligible for care coordination under the program, you must:

- identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person and attend a mainstream general practice in the Coffs Harbour, Bellingen or Nambucca Valley region
- be receiving care for your chronic health condition at your medical practice
- have a current Health Assessment and GP Management Plan and/or Team Care Arrangement
- have a written ITC referral from your doctor
- have at least one pre-existing chronic condition
- sign the Consent to release form and return to Galambila.
